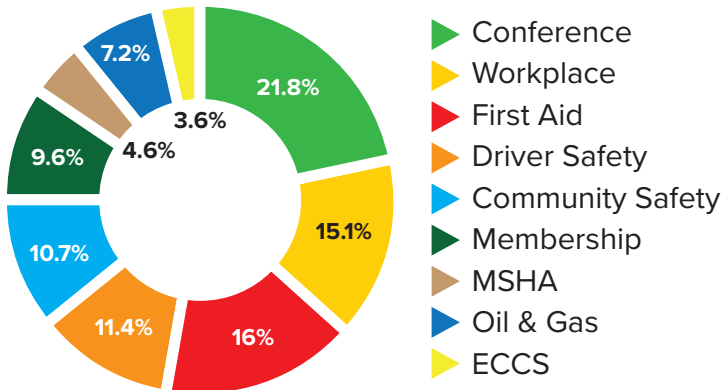

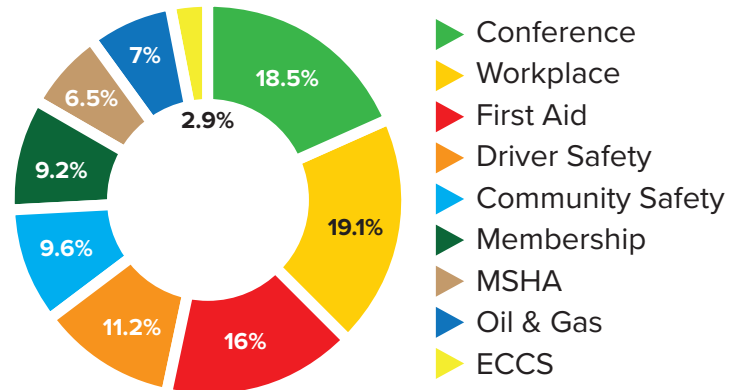

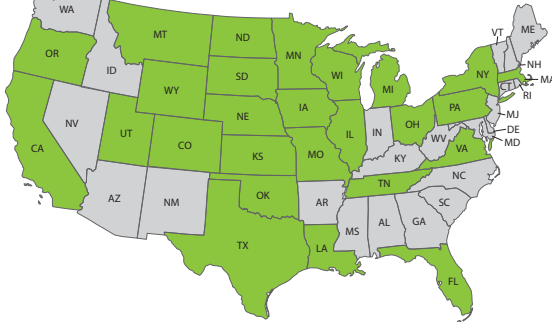


MEMBERSHIP SNAPSHOT

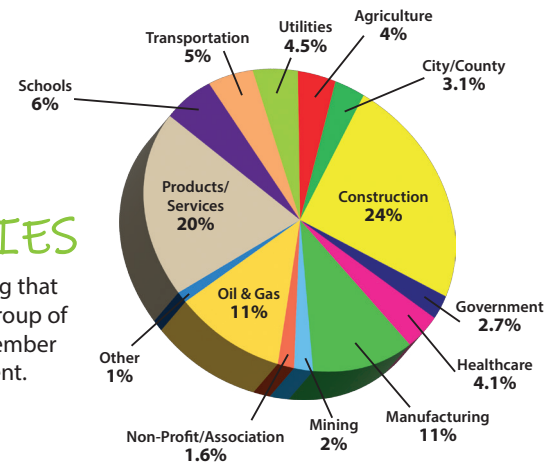
Membership **IMPACT**
